NOTICE OF DETERMINATION OF SUFFICIENT
ALLEGATIONS OF VIOLATIONS

The Respondent and the Complainant herein are hereby notified that:

1. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 36-14-12(c)(2), and Commission Regulation 1003(b), the Rhode Island Ethics Commission determined on October 7, 2008, that the above-captioned Complaint alleges facts sufficient to constitute a violation of the provisions of the Rhode Island Code of Ethics.

2. Pursuant to the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the Commission will make reasonable accommodations to furnish appropriate auxiliary aids and services when necessary to afford an individual with a disability with an equal opportunity to participate in Commission proceedings and have access to Commission documents. 3. The Commission will conduct an investigation of the allegations contained in the Complaint, pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 36-14-12(c), and Commission Regulation 1004. You will be informed of further action pursuant to the requirements of the Code of Ethics.

4. Pursuant to Commission Regulation 1005, you may file an Answer with the Commission on the form which is enclosed. Your Answer is due within twenty (20) days of the mailing date of this document. If you need a reasonable accommodation, pursuant to the ADA, to file your Answer, your request for such accommodation must be received by the 29th day of October, 2008 at 4:30 p.m., at the Commission Office. You may contact the ADA Coordinator as provided in paragraph (2) above.

5. If you intend to be represented by an attorney, your attorney must sign and file the enclosed Entry of Appearance.
